S.S.G hospital, Vadodara is tertiary care hospital attached to medical college baroda. S.S.G. hospital has 1513 beds and renders services to about 1500 patients per day on OPD basis and on an average daily 950 patients are served on IPD bases.

Hari om seva trust is registered social service organization which provides its services to many poor, needy and vulnerable patients attending S.S.G hospital. The trust has been provided with an office within the hospital premises.


The trust provides financial assistance to the poorest of poor patients for performing diagnostic investigations such as blood investigations, EEG, CT scan, MRI scan etc. The trust also arranges for costly drugs, for the patients from especially lower socio-economic group, such as intravenous injectable immunoglobins for the patients who are suffering from GB syndrome, anti cancer drugs, costly implants to orthopedic and neurosurgical patients, which costs thousands of rupees.

They have extended their helping hands to poor patient requiring hip & knee replacement. For the first time in the history of orthopaedics, >70 hip replacements & >75 knee replacements were performed on poor patients in duration of 1 year (2014-15) and this is being continued in 2015-16 as well. This was all possible because of financial help from Hari Om Seva Trust to poor patients.

We also know that this trust also been helping in kidney transplant to poor patients attending institute of kidney, disease and research center ahmedabad on receiving recommendation from doctors of IKDRC.

We have seen all trustees attending S.S.G. hospital every day and help patients. They have made close bondings with doctors, paramedical and other staff members of our hospital.

The trust has done an excellent work in supporting the medical services at our hospital and in alleviating pain and misery of poor patients. I hope the trust continues its social service efforts with vigour in the year to come. I also wish that philanthropists would help the trust in all possible ways so that it can expand its social service.
