ANNUAL REPORT 2022-23

Healthcare was the biggest challenge during the Corona virus waves but with the year 2022, it began working into a road to recovery. Normalcy came into the lives of people as hospitals began taking patients for their long standing chronic health issues as well as acute ones. People too started visiting hospitals for their immediate medical problems without fear of the virus. At Hari Om Seva Trust, the work had been continued online during the pandemic but it was time to come back to offline patient and doctor interactions and give them the much needed help. With majority of vaccinations done and govt restrictions lifting, the offline medical help was started on 20th August 22 at GMERS hospital, Gotri and in November at S.S.G hospitals.

The offices at both hospitals were renovated keeping in mind the safety as well as efficient interactions between the patients, doctors and volunteers.

Total number of patients seen at both hospitals were 40,043.

Total expenses incurred towards all the activities was Rs 140.22 Lakhs in the year 2022-23.

ACTIVITIES IN 2022-2023

1) ACTIVITIES AT S.S.G HOSPITAL

S.S.G Hospital is one of the biggest and oldest hospitals at Vadodara. And in the year 2022-23, Hari Om Seva Trust supported 22,899 patients for their various medical expenses. Patients helped in various categories:

Subsidised cost of medicines through the use of generic medicines as well as maximum discount given to us by the attached chemists, Hari Om Seva Trust was able to help the poor and needy patients with their medical needs. The trust also extended sizeable support for Hip, Knee replacements, Shoulder arthroplasty, Artificial bone graft operation, etc by arranging for ceramic heads, distal loadings, tibia/femur rods and various implants. For ligament repairs, fibre wires, stitch loops, etc were provided at low cost. Cancer and Chemotherapy drugs were given at subsidised rates looking into their long term treatments and patients age and income to sustain the therapies.

MRI/CT Scans and USG were directed to Paramount Diagnostics for subsidised diagnosis due to long wait list at the SSG hospital and the urgency of the patients for diagnosis.

2) ACTIVITIES AT GMERS HOSPITAL

GMERS HOSPITAL too has gained popularity to the population residing in the west side of the city and its adjacent villages. It too is a well equipped hospital with all the words functioning fully with well trained doctors and staff. Our Office at GMERS is also strategically located on the first floor of the building and attended by trustees and volunteers in the morning OPD. Help extended is similar to S.S.G and availed by the needy patients. Total no of patients seen were 17,144 in the year 2022-23.

Most of the patients visiting this hospital are low income but affordable patients so help extended to them is according to their income and long term needs. Major support at this hospital is with the MRI/CT Scan/USG as the infrastructure is

still developing and the service far exceeds the demands. Dedicated volunteers give their time in doing the services for the poor patients.

Hari Om Seva Trust has also volunteered to distribute neonatal care kits to new born babies in the paediatric ward and maintain a record for the same. These kits are being supplied by United Way of Vadodara and Lalit Patel Foundation.

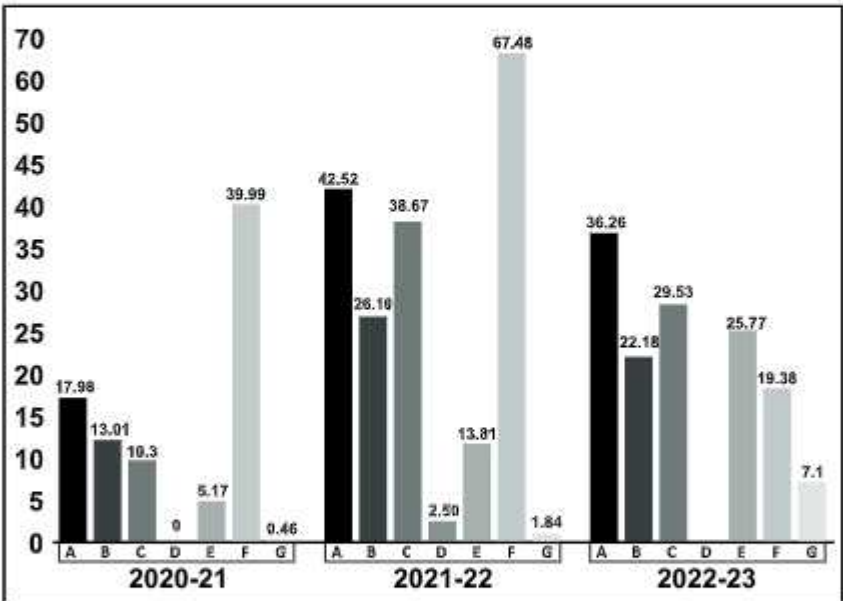
3) EDUCATION

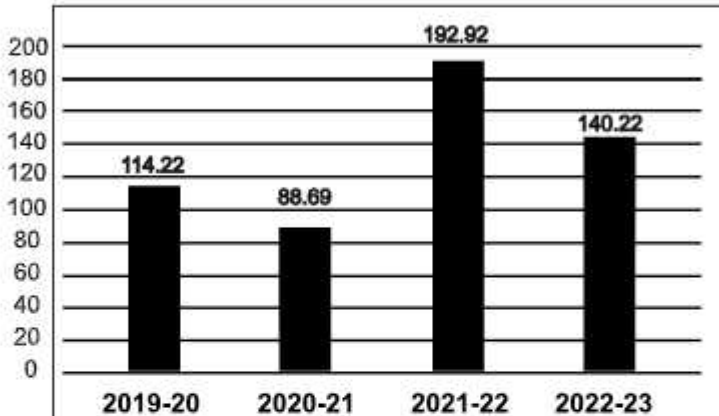

The final dispersion of amount was done at space provided by Vadil Parivar at Samta society with the help of our active trustees and volunteers. Total amount distributed to the students was Rs. 25.77L. We are grateful to our Trustee Mr Anshuman Shah and his wife who have taken over the mantle to manage this activity with dedication.

Hari Om Seva Trust supports Anand Ashram for their educational activities and have donated a sum of Rs 3.54L for the same.

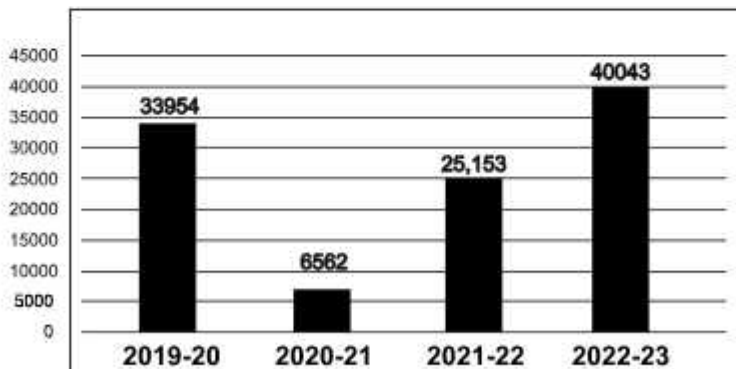
- A) ■ MEDICINE & CANCER CHEMO B) ■ RADIOLOGY

Our support to Dr Ashok Gohil who is running a DIABETIC CARE CLINIC at Kevadia colony continues. The trust provided medicines worth Rs 53,798/- for his poor patients coming from tribal surrounding areas.

Eye Camps were suspended due to the Corona Virus since last two years. Hari Om Seva Trust has pledged to support 4-5 camps every month and the Camps are restarted from May 2023.

Hari Om Seva Trust is in the process of tying up with Tricolor Hospital and Baroda Heart hospital for subsidized, affordable diagnostic tests like Angiography, Echo cardiogram, EEG, EMT, MRI, CT scan, USG, etc. for the benefit of S.S.G and GMERS hospital patients. This will be in addition with Paramount Diagnostics and will reduce the wait time for the patients and help in early diagnosis.
