

ANNUAL REPORT 2023-24

HARI OM SEVA TRUST, a trusted name in healthcare services has been doing their philanthropic activities since 2001. In the 23 years of helping the poor patients

in the two biggest Govt. hospitals of Vadodara - Sir Sayaji General Hospital and GMERS hospital, it has worked relentlessly and efficiently in providing for health and wellbeing of the sick. It is run entirely by a group of retired people who have decided to use their free time in helping the poor for their medical needs. Over the year volunteers and donors have joined in, impressed by the dedication and selflessness of the trustees and the work that has been done over the years. With time ,each year, work has grown to encompass more patients and diverse healthcare needs.

The 2023-24 brought back life into near normalcy after the Covid outbreaks. Patients with their chronic issues, long Covid symptoms, infections and surgical interventions surged and both the hospitals saw increasing number of patients. With this influx, the footfalls seeking help from Hari Om Trust also increased at the trust offices as both hospitals started offline services. Total number of patients attended to at both S.S.G and Gotri Hospitals were 41,349.

ACTIVITIES IN 2023-2024

1) ACTIVITIES AT S.S.G HOSPITAL

S.S.G Hospital is one of the oldest and largest hospital at Vadodara. In the year 2023-24, Hari Om Trust has provided monetary and medical aids to 22,968 patients. Patients provided help in different categories:

Cost of Medicines have skyrocketed and has become beyond the reach of the poor patients going to Govt Hospitals. Although these hospitals do provide medicines too; often they are in short supply or unavailable. The use of generic medicines by Doctors too has been helpful but yet many others are prescribed for good results.

Sayaji Hospital has a bigger influx of patients and often has to deal with unscheduled needs for medicines as also delay in receiving them. Hari Om Trust has attached with Sayaji Chemists, outside the premises of the hospital, to give maximum discount to the patients coming with the Hari Om form. The trust also subsidised the cost with monetary help.

Cancer drugs are subsidised and available through **Unity Chemists**.

Pathology tests with **Amin Labs & Path Labs** are available at highly subsidised rates as often the results are needed in emergency and not provided by the Hospital. Many diagnostic tests have to be done externally as these too are not done at the govt hospitals. As above figures show, 12335 patients needed some or the other pathology reports. Further the amount for the tests was reduced by Hari Om trust with the monetary help given to them as per the patients financial capacity.

Orthopaedic surgeries included Total Hip and Knee replacements, Shoulder Arthroplasty, Shoulder Arthroscopy, artificial bone grafts, soft tissues reconstructions and illizarov like reformative corrective surgeries etc. For all above surgeries, surgical implants, rods, loops, wires, etc were provided at lower costs by the trust. These surgeries particularly helped those poor patients who did not have an Ayushmann card, BPL card or Senior Citizen card and were needing them urgently.

MRI, CT SCANS, USG, etc were directed to **Paramount Diagnostics and Tricolour hospital** and done on lower rates along with monetary help provided by the trust.

Hari Om Trust acted as a mediator in procuring UNICOM SYSTEM AND DRILL SYSTEM for the Orthopaedic dept. This was supplied by M/S Standard Pesticides Pvt Ltd. at a cost of 13.42 Lakhs. This machine can be used for various surgeries and can be shared by 4 Departments at S.S.G. for its use.

2) ACTIVITIES AT GMERS HOSPITAL

The Gotri Medical Education and Research Speciality Hospital has been looking into the needs of the people of Vadodara and surrounding villages on the western side of the city. It has been functioning since 2011 and has gradually increased their departments and area of medical services over the years. Hari Om Trust has been given an office on the first floor of the main building and has been attended by dedicated trustees and volunteers in their morning OPDs. The hospital is well stocked with the medicines but still under developed in their Pathology depts and other diagnostic tests like MRI,CT SCANS, etc. Hence the needs of the patients, as seen by the chart, for help differs from S.S.G Hospital:

Special type of machine used for Vacuum Dressings was needed at GMERS. This is a special type of dressings used by the Surgical and Orthopaedic Depts for big wounds that do not get healed easily. It is majorly used to collect the pus and dry the wound faster with its dressing materials. It was supplied by Hari Om Trust at the cost of Rs 4.56L.


3) EDUCATION


Education is again another field that Hari Om Trust has been supporting actively since many years. Many impoverished ,low income families with very bright children are supported by giving them monetary help. As the word is spreading more parents are coming over for help as they are unable to support the heavy tuition fees of their bright children. These children are helped from school education onwards till they complete their college education. This year 497 children were supported at the cost incurring of Rs 35.78 Lakhs.


The selection and disbursement of help is conducted ably by Trustee Anshuman Shah and his wife Pravina at the premises of Vadil Parivar, Saimi Society. The selection and final cheques are given to the wards directly after being selected. We are grateful to Vadil Parivar society and their office bearers for giving us the assistance and space to conduct the whole process that takes about 4-5 days.

Hari Om Seva Trust also supports Anand Ashram activities towards educational help. 59 students were supported through them . Total cost spent was Rs 3.99 Lakhs.

4) OTHER ACTIVITIES

We are supporting a DIABETIC CARE UNIT run by Dr Ashok Gohil at Kevadia colony with monetary help. We are still continuing to help the poor tribal patients from around Kevadia and surrounding villages for their diabetic medicines and other needs.

The EYE CAMPS have started regularly in the villages and are being conducted through Divya Jyoti Eye Hospital, Mandvi, Surat dist. They are done by the team of Dr Uday Gajiwala. They are doing yeoman service to the old with their various eye issues. Hari Om Seva trust has supported 503 surgeries at the cost of Rs 1.26Lakhs.

Hari Om Seva has tied up with various private hospitals which have agreed to see patients, sent by the trust , at subsidised rates. These are for diagnostic tests that are not being done at the Govt hospitals and are needed for proper treatment. We are grateful to these hospitals and the Doctors who have agreed to help those patients at their lowest rates. Averagely 25-30 patients are sent daily to these various hospitals from S.S.G and GMERS hospitals and these numbers do not even reflect in our total patients seen yearly.

- 2D Echo, TMT, Holter Monitering for Cardiac patients is being done at Baroda Heart Hospital, TriColor Hospital and Bankers Heart Hospital. We are thankful to **Dr Baserge and Dr Darshan Banker** for providing these services
- 2. EEG, NCV, etc for Neurology patients, above the age of 16 years, is being done at VINS Hospital under the care of **Dr Mihir Acharya**. He has been giving these services at subsidised rates since many years. We are grateful for his philanthropic gesture.

Dr Smruti Patel, Advance Multi Speciality Hospitals sees patients below the age of 16 for their neurological tests. We extend our gratitude to her involvement and help.

- 3. **Dr Tushar Vaishnav and Dr Vikram Patel**, Muni Ashram help in Kidney related issues and DTPA Scans. Patients are charged very minimal amount as fixed by Hari Om trust with them.
- 4. **Dr Prashant Buch** has been doing subsidised Endoscopy and Colonoscopy for the patients directed to them by Hari Om Trust. We are thankful to him for his participation in our philanthropic activities.
- 5. Trance Ecofocal Eco Cardiology tests for heart and abdominal problems is done by **Dr Anand Ahuja** at Ridham Hospital. We thank him and extend our gratitude for the same.

Apart from the above help in diagnostic tests, the patients often has to go home with disposable Surgical Equipments for complete healing and relief from pain. Hari Om Seva Trust has started donating the following items to the patients at the lowest rates or often free too. Trust has spent Rs 1.85 Lakhs towards these equipments.

My Great Experience at Hari Om Seva Trust Trustee - Prakash Patankar

Long live Hari Om Seva Trust

Years ago, Rajesh Ahuja, a personal friend, took me to the Manjusar industrial area to show me a site on which he was planning to build a large food processing factory. On our way back he offered to take me to SSG hospital to show the work being done by Hari Om Seva Trust of which he was the President. At my age when our children tell us to enjoy life at home and not take unnecessary risks, I saw the trust



volunteers, all of them well past senior citizenship, putting themselves on the line and providing assistance to the poor and needy patients. This included a volunteer personally taking an old lady around on a wheel chair. I was truly inspired.

And this is how I ended up meeting Suresh bhai Shah, a stern guru like figure, at GMERS Hospital Gotri one morning, wanting to become a volunteer. It was amusing to realise that at 70, I was the youngest of the volunteers that included some inspiring characters. And this is how I ended up being a part of the trust 3 days a week at GMERS.

When the Government of India imposed a nationwide Corona lockdown on 24th March 2020, the trust service had to be stopped because our volunteers were not permitted to come to the hospital. This created a peculiar situation where the need to serve patients was even greater and the donor money was available but the service could not be delivered.

A chance meeting with a young CA, Vinit Shah, planted an idea in my mind that why not we attempt to deliver the trust service remotely using information technology. When a rough-cut idea was presented to the trust seniors, the reaction was one of incredulity and rightly so.

However, Rajesh bhai continued to provide encouragement and after several trial runs in June & July, the trustees and the hospital administrations gave a green signal and full-fledged service was restored online from August 2020.

Paramount Diagnostics, our partners for pathology and radiology tests and their technicians played a notable role in making this possible. Thus, Hari Om Seva Trust was able to deliver on its commitment to patients even during the entire difficult Corona epidemic period.

Over these many years I thoroughly enjoyed doing the work at GMERS and it was truly with a heavy heart that I said good bye to the trust in September last year as I had decided to shift to Bangalore permanently to be closer to my son who runs a software business there.

I do often remember the volunteers, the truly inspiring larger than life characters, like Babani sir who is on call 24 hours, Ramesh Patel who has almost no vision but came to Gotri hospital every morning on his own taking public transport, Mahesh Trivedi when he walked in happiness & cheer walked in too, Suresh Shah the kindly but very methodical boss who treated all of us to a cup of tea every morning and the energy of Anshuman Shah.

Most mornings I still miss the camaraderie of my colleagues, the smells, the sights, and the sounds of patients at our office at GMERS, that is how life is, I guess.

My best wishes are with all those who make Hari Om Seva Trust possible. May their tribe grow.
